All GAR cats are 'prepared' for entering the UK according to DEFRA requirements. In addition, they are blood-tested, which, although not required under the PETS travel scheme, we feel is important. The adoption fee/donation is £295. This amount barely covers half the expenses incurred for preparation of the dog for travel (vaccinations, microchip, blood tests, sterilisation (unless a young kitten when the new owner would cover the cost), passport, transportation costs etc), but it helps towards the expenses of preparing another animal for homing in the UK and thus secures their future.
