Please note - unfortunately, due to our insurance cover, we can't home dogs where there are children of 7-yrs or younger, nor to flats or homes without an enclosed garden area. All GAR dogs are sterilised (excluding puppies). All dogs/puppies are 'prepared' for entering the UK according to DEFRA requirements. In addition, they're blood-tested for Leishmaniasis, Ehrlichia, Babesia, Anaplasma, Brucellosis and Heartworm, which, although not required under the PETS travel scheme, we feel is important. We also register your pet's microchip to you pre-arrival on the UK PetTrac database.

The adoption fee/donation for one of our dogs is £600. This can be paid in four monthly instalments if preferred. This amount is for the preparation of the dog for travelling to the UK and includes all vaccinations, microchipping, blood tests and sterilisation, plus the fee charged by our commercial transporters, which is our single biggest expense. In the case of puppies too young to sterilise, our adoption fee/donation is reduced to £500, and when your puppy reaches adulthood, we ask you to ensure it's sterilised.
